

# WEEK 9 SUSTAINABILITY- GREENHOUSE IN A BOTTLE



**Learning Intention** – This week we are creating our own mini green house from recycled bottles.

**Success Criteria** –

- Use a recycled bottle, any size will do, to watch a seed germinate into a seedling and then a plant
- You might choose to use just the top, as a lid in an outside garden, or make the base into a pot and watch it grow inside the house

## HOW TO MAKE A GREENHOUSE IN A BOTTLE

1. Cut a bottle in half
2. Place soil, or potting mix, in the bottom half along with a seed... or 2
3. Water the soil well and cover with the lid
4. You won't need to water again until the condensation dries up on the lid
5. Wait
6. Wait some more
7. A little longer...
8. Watch it grow!
9. Where will you plant your seedling?
