Some questions to ask your kids about their reading:

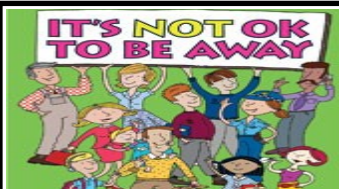
- What do you think this will be about?
